#### **UNIT 4**

# <u>Talk</u> (**11 items**)

This Syllabus Item provides practice of the kind of language we use to talk about language, culture, conversations, tendencies and family members. It covers 'wh-' words and present and past tendencies with 'will' and 'would'.



3 language exercises, 2 grammar items, 1 vocabulary activity, 4 listening activities and 1 pronunciation activity.

#### UNIT 5

# Luck (15 items)

This Syllabus Item provides practice of the kind of language we use to talk about luck, wishes, regrets and science fiction. It covers unreal conditionals and statements with 'wish', 'if only' and 'regret'.

3 language exercises, 6 grammar items, 2 vocabulary activities and 4 listening activities.

#### UNIT 6

# Mind (11 items)

This Syllabus Item provides practice of the kind of language we use to talk about the brain and intelligence. It covers stative verbs, participle clauses and expressions with 'mind'.

2 language exercises, 3 grammar items, 3 vocabulary activities, 1 listening activity and 2 pronunciation activities.

#### **UNIT 7**

#### Review 1 (10 items)

This Syllabus Item provides further practice of the language points revised in the Student's Book unit. It also includes two games and a web project that provide supplementary material.

#### UNIT 8

# Cyberspace (18 items)

# Law (14 items)

This Syllabus Item provides practice of the kind of language we use to talk about crime, legal cases and news stories. It covers the use of modals to talk about the present and the past and inversion after 'neither', 'nor', 'so' and 'such'.

2 language exercises, 6 grammar items, 1 vocabulary activity, 4 listening activities and 1 pronunciation activity.

#### **UNIT 10**

# Firsts (17 items)

This Syllabus Item provides practice of the kind of language we use to talk about challenges and achievements. It covers connectors and active and passive verbs.

9 language exercises, 1 grammar item, 3 vocabulary activities, 2 listening activities and 2 pronunciation activities.

#### **UNIT 11**

# Stories (10 items)

This Syllabus Item provides practice of the kind of language we use to tell stories and talk about urban myths. It covers compound adjectives and the future in the past.
